
Overview








Public sector

Factors such as new project acquisitions absorbed the reactionary decline in large projects and became a growth trend in the fourth quarter.




Steady progress of existing projects contributed to support segment performance.

<Increase in sales and profits> Accelerating growth of new and existing businesses with network infrastructure and mission-critical business systems.




- I There is a market shift to cloud computing and increased demand for cloud services. Increased opportunities for orders through inter-division collaboration.


I New projects won primarily in Tokyo and Osaka contributed to performance.








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
Continued stable management with steady progress in sales activities, capital investment, and repayment

- While the number of shares held by financial institutions and securities firms decreased, the number of shares held by individuals and foreign investors increased.






Projections for the Fiscal Year Ending March 2023 (47th Business Year)


